## CUSTOMER-OWNED UNDERGROUND FACILITY LOCATION AGREEMENT

When boring, trenching, or excavating, there are several important items to keep in mind. Many cables and pipes are underground and out-of-sight.

It is the customer's responsibility to locate their privately-owned underground facilities. These facilities include, but are not limited to, water lines (potable and irrigation), sewer lines, and electrical wires. Listed below are some examples of underground facilities that you, the customer, are responsible for locating:

Gas lines.

Irrigation or drainage lines.

Any conductor, pipe, aggregate, buried equipment or facility on customer property.

Septic tank.

Underground perimeter fences (electronic dog fences).

Sewer taps that connect the buildings to the main sewer. These are customer-owned and will not be located by the sewer company.

Water lines that connect buildings to the water company's main lines. Any water lines that are between the water meter and any buildings are customer-owned. The water company will not locate these water lines.

Customer-owned electrical/communication wires. For example, underground wiring that may lead from a building to a customer owned lamp, storage building, or any other customer-owned property.

While Santee Cooper will go to great lengths to avoid damage to customer-owned facilities, there are times when damage does occur. Sod should be installed only after Santee Cooper installs electrical equipment on the customer's property. Santee Cooper will not move and replace sod. Water pipes leading from a well pump or from a water meter should be installed only after Santee Cooper installs electrical equipment on the customer's property. Concrete or asphalt driveways should be installed only after Santee Cooper installs electrical equipment on the customer's property.
